

WARRANTY

This optical product from SWAROVSKI OPTIK is a high-quality instrument that comes with a worldwide warranty from the date of purchase of 10 years for the monocular and 2 years for the electronics in accordance with the following conditions:

If defects in the materials and/or the workmanship occur, we will pay the material costs for the entire warranty period. We reserve the right in such instances to repair or replace the instrument or the defective part at our discretion. During the first five years we will also pay the labor costs.

This warranty does not restrict the manufacturer's statutory warranty obligations.

If our product range changes, we reserve the right to repair faulty instruments or to replace them with equivalent products.

The following special regulations exist because of the basic function and design of optronic instruments: As far as is functionally necessary, we supply all devices ready to use, with branded batteries installed or enclosed. We cannot assume any liability for these batteries; the warranty rules of the respective manufacturers apply, and they have their own warranty conditions - particularly with regard to damage caused by leaking batteries.

This warranty is void if repairs are carried out by a service workshop not authorized by SWAROVSKI OPTIK or if damage is caused by improper use. The warranty does not cover direct or indirect damage caused by defects in the instrument. The warranty also does not cover any components which are subject to natural wear, including eyecups, carrying straps, cases, armoring, etc.

The warranty is only valid if this warranty/service document is properly dated, signed, and stamped by the specialist retailer on the day of purchase.

If you want to make a warranty claim or have your instrument serviced and/or repaired, you must hand over the instrument and this warranty/service document to your SWAROVSKI OPTIK specialist dealer or send them directly to us free of charge. Instruments without this warranty/service document will be repaired at your expense. In the case of warranty repairs, the instrument will be returned free of charge using an insured shipment method of our choice. In other cases, you will be charged for shipment. If instruments are shipped abroad, any foreign customs duties or taxes must be paid by the recipient.

This warranty is granted by SWAROVSKI OPTIK KG, Absam, Austria. The place of jurisdiction is Innsbruck and it is governed by Austrian law.

If other warranties/guarantees (either statutory or voluntary) are agreed in other countries, they must be fulfilled by the importer or specialist retailer. SWAROVSKI OPTIK KG, Absam, Austria, can only accept liability when it is under a legal obligation to do so.
